

## Can Mom Get A Free Cell Phone?

The answer is yes for Medicaid recipients and others. The Assurance Wireless Lifeline Cell Phone Service is available for free to participants in the following programs:

- Medicaid
- Food Stamps/SNAP
- Temporary Assistance to Needy Families
- Federal Public Housing Assistance or Section 8
- Low Income individuals
- National School Lunch Program Free Lunch

Eligible individuals get a free cell phone and 250 minutes a month of free calls/texts. You can call the toll-free number (888)-898-4888 or visit [www.assurancewireless.com/Public/Welcome.aspx](http://www.assurancewireless.com/Public/Welcome.aspx) to enroll. You usually get your free phone within a week!
