All Indiana residents can print off a prescription drug discount card by simply visiting [www.indianadrugcard.com](http://www.indianadrugcard.com) and entering their first and last name. If you do not have a computer the pharmacy can help you get a card. The discount card is accepted at over 56,000 pharmacies nationwide including Walmart, CVS, Walgreens, Kroger, and Target. There are no complicated forms to complete. There is no application process. There are no age, asset, or income requirements or limitations. Discounts can range from 35%-75%; and, best of all, the card is free!

The next time you have a prescription to fill, simply take your printed card and present it to your pharmacy. If you do not have health insurance you will instantly enjoy the savings. If you do have health insurance the discount card may still provide some benefit. It can be used to reduce out-of-pocket expenses with a high deductible insurance plan. It can reduce the cost of prescriptions that are not covered by insurance. The card can be used if you are in the donut hole under a Medicare Part D plan; however, the cost of the prescriptions will not count toward meeting the coverage cost to get out of the donut hole. This card will be most beneficial used late in the calendar year when it appears you will not meet the donut hole requirements.
